What matters to you

- **Priority 1: Anti-Social Behaviour (ASB) in derelict buildings**

You said: That people have been entering derelict properties and causing ASB at locations across the Knighton area.

We did: The team have been conducting patrols to deter youths from entering empty buildings. We have been engaging with groups, offered words of advice and education around some of the dangers of abandoned buildings. We are working with partners to try and speed up planning or demolition for these buildings. We also are in contact with the owners of the buildings and ensuring that they are doing their bit to keep the perimeters secure so that persons cannot enter.

- **Priority 2: Burglaries**

You said: That you are concerned by the number of burglaries across the Knighton area.

We did: We have been on the beat posting leaflets to educate local residents about keeping your home safe and secure now darker nights are drawing in. We will continue to conduct high visible patrols and maintain a strong policing presence in the community, we will also be holding beat engagements for crime prevention tips.

- **Priority 3: Drugs & ASB**

You said: ASB and drug use in the Church Lane/Lych Gate area is a problem.

We did: The team have continued to conduct patrols in these areas to deter issues and try and identify suspects, officers spoke with several youths and a few of them took advice and are now on drug rehabilitation programmes.

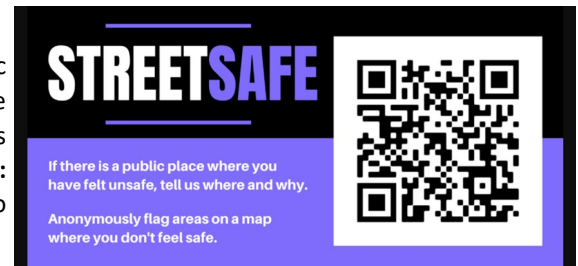
Other Local News
