## News

This summer, Leicestershire Police is supporting a nationwide campaign aimed at making communities safer, more vibrant and welcoming for everyone during the summer months. Assistant Chief Constable Adam Streets said: "We welcome the Government's Safer Street Summer initiative as a timely and important step in supporting our communities. "Our officers will be working closely with local partners, businesses, and residents to target those things which matter most to our communities." As part of the initiative, Leicestershire Police will be:

- Increasing patrols in identified key areas, town centres and green spaces.
- Hosting community safety and youth engagement events.
- Cracking down on anti-social behaviour, through swift and visible enforcement.
- Collaborating with local councils and support services to address the root causes of crime.



During one shift on Patrol at Fosse Park PC Meg and Special Constable Nadia were kept very busy, apart from walking over 9000 steps they stop-searched 2 suspects and recovered stolen items, 2 individuals were arrested and 2 out-of-court disposals were issued banning shoplifters from Fosse Park and targeting stores.

As part of ASB Awareness Week PCSO Ellis and PCSO Calum had the privilege of participating in an event at Everards Meadows in collaboration with Blaby District Council and Leicestershire Fire and Rescue Service. During this event, we focused on promoting the importance of reporting anti-social behaviour, engaging with young people and families, and providing valuable crime prevention advice. We appreciate the community's involvement and encourage everyone to remain vigilant and report any ASB they suffer over the summer period.

As part of the Safer Streets Summer Campaign at Fosse Park, the entire NH20 Beat team were in attendance at McDonalds at Fosse Park, unfortunately this is known to be one of the hot spots of ongoing Anti-Social Behaviour. We were happy to meet local residents and those from around the County and to grab a bite to eat and engage with us. Thank you to all whom attended.

We have received numerous reports of off road bikes, often with pillion passengers onboard riding around Littlethorpe and Narborough. The bikes are on occasion riding on pavements and being ridden dangerously. If you have any knowledge of whom these individuals are please call on 101.
