#YouSaidWeDid -

Beat priorities focus on the issues that matter most within our communities.

These priorities are shaped by you, and they give us the opportunity to address the concerns that affect your daily life.

You Said- Youth related Anti-social behaviour (ASB) in Spittal Park, Castle Donington, was becoming an issue.

We Did- We are pleased to report that ASB on Spittal Park has significantly decreased. Through visible patrols, target hardening and our ongoing multi-agency approach to problem solving, the issue has decreased and we are receiving positive feedback about the facility.

You Said -There has been an increase in ASB in the Wheatcroft Lane area, Castle Donington.

We Did- Encourage the housing association to start the incremental process with the relevant tenants, maintained visible patrols to act as a deterrent and have continued to develop intelligence with a view to take enforcement action if required.

You Said- Vehicle related anti-social behaviour on Diseworth Road, Castle Donington continues to cause a nuisance.

We Did- Identified breaches of PSPO for NWLDC to action and issue fixed penalty notices. Have continued to show a visible presence to act as a deterrent and have arranged another multi-agency meeting to ensure sustainable progress is made.

Darker Nights Incoming-

The Darker Nights Campaign is a seasonal crime prevention initiative, which aims to help protect communities during the autumn and winter months. Longer hours of darkness can provide greater opportunities for burglary, vehicle crime and anti-social behaviour. The campaign focuses on increasing high-visibility patrols, targeting known offenders, and providing practical crime prevention advice to residents. This includes encouraging people to lock doors and windows, use timer switches on lights, secure vehicles, and remain vigilant for suspicious activity.

INSURANCE, TAX and MOT -

Keeping your vehicle taxed, insured and MOT compliant is not only a legal requirement, it is also an important part of keeping yourself and others safe on the road.

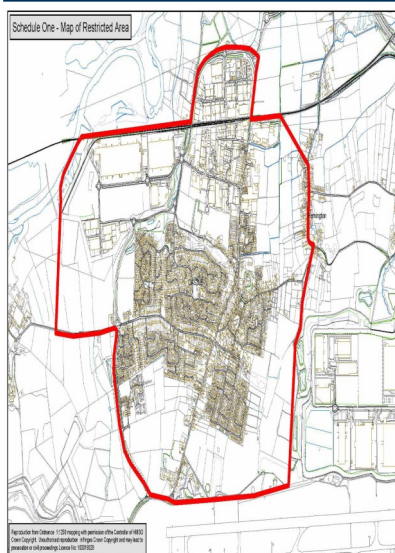
Vehicle tax helps fund the maintenance and improvement of the UK's road network, while insurance provides financial protection if you are involved in a collision, helping to cover damage, injuries and other associated costs. Driving without insurance can result in significant penalties, including fines, penalty points and vehicle seizures.

An MOT ensures that your vehicle meets minimum road safety and environmental standards. Regular testing can identify defects before they become serious problems, reducing the risk of breakdowns and collisions caused by faulty vehicles.

Failing to keep your vehicle taxed, insured or MOT compliant can lead to fines, prosecution and increased costs in the future. By staying on top of these responsibilities, motorists can help keep the roads safer, protect themselves financially and ensure their vehicle remains legal to drive.



Castle Donington - Public Space Protection Order



Since July 2024, Castle Donington has been subject to a renewed Public Space Protection Order (PSPO). The order, made by North West Leicestershire District Council, prohibits:

- 1- Any person participating in a Car Cruise (the activity).
- 2- Any person congregating for the purpose of being a spectator at a Car Cruise
- 3- Any person allowing a vehicle, for which they are the registered keeper, to be used in a Car Cruise.

This order enables the local district council to issue Fixed Penalty Notice to anyone that they have reason to believe has committed an offence in relation to this Order.

Over 100 vehicles have been ticketed for this type of behaviour with both Leicestershire Police and NWLDC taking a zero tolerance approach. We remain committed to tackling this issue.
