### What matters to you

We have revised our beat priorities as of July 2025 to reflect what we have been told concerns the community most.

- Priority 1: ASB and Seasonal Crime—Victoria park. Over the summer, we will be expecting the Parks and open spaces
  in the area to become increasingly busy. Along with park users, visitors and events we will be collating instances of
  crimes and ASB to establish patterns and find sustainable solutions to persisting issues. SAFER STREETS is an initiative
  launched in July 2025 which will hopefully see more police officers in your area.
  - **What we did:** Our colleagues at Leicester City Council parks teams will now be able to work closer with Leicestershire Police with their new working patterns. We will be supporting each other with enforcement of Bi-laws to ensure the parks remain a safe place.
- **Priority 2: e-Scooters and e-Bikes -** Ongoing concerns of e-scooters and bikes being ridden anti-socially in the Clarendon Park area.
  - **What we did:** To date; across Clarendon Park and neighbouring areas, an approx. 300 E-scooters and bikes have been seized. We will be continuing with Op. Pedalfast for the foreseeable.
- **Priority 3: Vehicle Crime** We will carry on with our initiatives to remind and re-educate about vehicle security over the summer months.
  - What we Did: Patrols will be carried out in residential areas and vehicles checked routinely as part of patrol plans.

#### **Other Local News**

- **Victoria Park**—Granville Road car park continues to be an area of interest, Tickets have been issued along with Section 59 Notices and cars have been seized in ongoing efforts to curb Vehicle related ASN.
- **Licensing**—Following a successful enforcement with Leicester City council where £13,000 worth of items were seized from a premises. We are continuing to work with the licensing team and gathering intelligence on businesses that are causing concern.
- **Burglaries**—Reports have lessened, but we would like to encourage vigilance when it comes to leaving windows and doors open during the summer months.
