**Priority 1:** ASB. **What we are going to do:** The beat team aim to tackle different elements of ASB in Anstey, Thurcaston, Cropston and Newtown Linford. Highlighted areas were both allotments in Anstey, Paper Mill Close and neighbouring recreational ground in Anstey, Mitchell's Field in Anstey, Bradgate Park.

**Priority 2:** Speeding and Road safety. **What we are going to do:** We will be looking at Road safety issues in Anstey and villages, including speeding, parking issues (especially around school times), obstructions in Anstey (in particular parking on Cropston Road), vehicles not complying with traffic signals in the Nook, and use of electric scooters in public places.

**Priority 3:** Drugs. What we are going to do: We are aware of areas where drugs are used, especially in public areas and causing distress for others. We are also aware of certain addresses and areas where drugs are dealt. We will be targeting these areas to try and cut this down. Please make contact with us if you have any information about this!

#### June 2025

The Anstey neighbourhood Team have been working throughout May to tackle our chosen priorities of Anti-Social Behaviour, Speeding/Road Traffic Safety, and Drugs.

All the team featuring Sergeant Adkin, PC Moore, and PCSO Jarvis have been working both out on the beat engaging with the community, and completing essential behind the scenes administrative work on the below:

#### **Anti-Social Behaviour**

We have patrolled all of these areas on several occasions over the last month, with thankfully no significant ASB reports. We do continue to have issues with electric motorbikes on Bradgate Park and continue to patrol here when possible. We will continue to patrol these areas and any others that may come to our attention over the coming month.

#### **Speeding and Road Traffic Safety**

We have patrolled these over the last month, in particular school parking and continue to gather intelligence on our patrols from local residents. We will continue to patrol over the coming month and take steps to enforce when and where possible. Due to demand this month, we have unfortunately been unable to complete any speed checks this month.

#### **Drugs**

We have patrolled these areas extensively several times over the last month and continue to gather intelligence on our patrols from local residents. We will continue to patrol over the coming month and take steps to enforce when and where possible.
