What matters to you

We have revised our beat priorities as of April 2026 to reflect what we have been told concerns the community most.

- **Priority 1: ASB in Open Spaces**

What we did: St.Mary's Triangle has been brought to our attention of late due to an increasing number of vehicles being reported abandoned in the area. We would still encourage these vehicles be reported for abandonment to Leicester City Council. Our officers have to the area to take note of the vehicles and we will be actioning reports that have come from our visits.

- **Priority 2: Theft and Shoplifting**

What we did: Discreet operations have been taking place sporadically on Queens Road due to a spike in thefts, with further work tracing those involved with where they have been taking their ill-gotten gains. As it stands, all suspects and associates have been identified by the team and officers from neighbouring areas.

- **Priority 3: Vulnerable People**

What we Did: We have been visiting and speaking to those most vulnerable in our community. This can be homeless, elderly/isolated, at risk of offending etc. We would still like to encourage members of our community to come forward with any concerns that we may potentially not know about.

Other Local News

- **Shop Thefts:** You may have seen or heard our officers on Queens Road in the early hours. This will be to combat the spree of bulk thefts that are on the increase. People have been arrested daily and are soon to be put in front of the courts.
- **Caribbean Carnival:** Caribbean carnival passed with little issues. As always; the turnout was fantastic, the attire, the music were a smashing tribute to the Crowd and Culture theme of this year.
- **Cap-man:** We've made strides in our work surrounding the man known as "cap-man". A Criminal Behaviour Order (CBO) has been drafted in respect of his behaviour, and is scheduled to be heard by the courts in his attendance. Watch this space.
- **University Welcome Week**—As far away as it seems, PC Bausor has already been meeting with the University of Leicester team in preparation for Welcome Week in September. Each year we have been working with the University and learned from previous issues in hope that students can integrate into student life as smoothly as possible and without causing too much disruption to the area during drop offs.
