## What matters to you

We have identified the following priorities which are in place as of 1st October 2025:

- **Priority 1: ASB**

**You Said:** We are aware of issues with youths causing anti-social behaviour in the area if Hillsborough Road and Thurcroft Close. We will be working to tackle this issue moving forward.

**We Did:** Officers have continued to deter anti-social behaviour in the area. We have noticed a drop in reporting and believe this to be due to last months positive action. We have visited an address and words of advice were issued to a youth with parents present. This should deter further issues. We continue to monitor further reports and urge local residents to report any concerns to us via 101 or online.

- **Priority 2: Drug Dealing**

**You Said:** We continue to carry this priority forward into October as you have advised us this remains a serious issue. We will continue to tackle those who blight the local area with drugs.

**We Did:** We continue to work closely with Leicester City Council where addresses are identified as being involved in drug supply and where Closure Orders may be viable. Due to current ongoing action against various addresses/persons, we are limited as to the update we can provide this month on this priority.

- **Priority 3: Shoplifting**

**You Said:** There has been an increase in retail theft over the summer months at local stores.

**We Did:** The beat team have been working with the Co-Op stores on the beat who appear to suffer most from repeat shoplifters. Visits to each Co-Op store have been completed by a local PCSO, who has reviewed with Management the processes of how we work together to ensure regular offenders are being reported and dealt with more effectively via the reporting methods in place. We have had two positive results with high profile shoplifters being put away for their repeat crimes.

- Thank you to the local residents who attended the Eyres Monsell Ward Meeting on Wednesday 26th November at the Eyres Monsell Community Centre. Some local policing issues were brought to our attention at the meeting and we will continue to tackle issues that matter most to local people.
- Thank you to all who attended the Christmas Event at Eyres Monsell Community Centre on Saturday 29th November. It was a pleasure for the local officers (PCSO CLAYTON and PC BOWEN) that attended. From speaking to the local Councillors, we hear the event was well attended, safe and very successful!
