You have told us you are experiencing issues with: Retail crime particularly focussed around the Haymarket Shopping Centre; Drug use and the associated anti-social behaviour around Angel Gateway and the Market Place; Anti-Social Behaviour around Abbey Park Campus, Memory Lane and the surrounding industrial areas.

What we will do

To tackle the issues raised we will conduct a number of focused actions which will include;

- Hold regular engagements with students at Leicester College discussing the impact of Anti-Social Behaviour and how to keep themselves safe.
- Conduct pro-active patrols around Abbey Park Campus focussing on identifying those committing anti-social behaviour and beginning the incremental approach to tackle this.
- Conduct reassurance and proactive visits to stores reporting shop thefts in order to identify offenders and bring them to justice.
- Hold engagements around the Market Place with partner agencies to offer support to those engaging in drug related activities.
- Conduct proactive patrols of hotspot areas to target offenders and bring them to justice.
