# What matters to you

A priority setting survey was recently sent out to Residents of the NR34 beat area however, it received very little in the way of a response, so the latest beat priorities have been set based on data from the previous year. They are as follows:

#### Priority 1. Road Safety

Road safety, namely speeding, out on the rural and village roads remains a priority for the beat, with numerous villages suffering from inconsiderate driving.

What we are going to do: Visible traffic calming remains a successful way of deterring speeding motorists out on the rural roads. Where able, the deployment of the SL700 "speed gun" will be utilised along with the issuing of Tickets and S.59 warnings. (and much more)

#### Priority 2. Farming Equipment Thefts and Rural Crime

Based on the very nature of the area, Rural Crime will likely always remain a priority for the Rural North Beat. Looking after our Rural Communities is of the utmost importance.

What we are going to do: We will continue patrols in isolated rural areas and visit victims of crime. We will also target those patrols based on current crime trends and intelligence. Where able, those that cause the most harm will be brought to justice.

#### **Priority 3. Vehicle Crime**

Vehicle crime, including breaks to work vans remains a priority for the Rural North beat.

What we are going to do: Targeted patrols, reviewing of evidence and keeping the community updated with the latest trends and crimes.

### What we are doing

Targeted Priority Activity summary:

### Monthly newsletter

Multiple patrols have been carried out in the areas that have been highlighted as most affected by inconsiderately driven and speeding vehicles.

Warning letters and traffic offence reports are issued when circumstances allow.

Continued community consultations and engagements better inform the beat team of the areas that need patrolling and enforcement activity carrying out, so please come along to any beat surgeries you see advertised in your area!

An investigation into an allegation of bad driving continues and it is likely that two very inconsiderate drivers will be having a knock on their door soon and will be issued with a S.59 warning. If 2 of these are issued in the space of 12 months, their vehicles will be seized by police.

A drink driver has been taken off the road having provided a positive breath test of 86 milligrams of alcohol per 100 milliliters of breath on an approved breathalyser device.

- Theft of hand tools from an allotment shed in Bottesford.

- Theft of diesel from a JCB parked on a farm yard in Eastwell.

- Agricultural vehicle stolen from a farm in the Waltham area.

### Village Matters

Bottesford: A significant increase in ASB with youths has been noted. Reports have been submitted and work with partners continues to identify those responsible. Those identified will be placed on the incremental approach.



Waltham On The Wolds: Report of a stolen vehicle in a field. Officers attend, recover the vehicle, leading to the arrest of 2 individuals on suspicion of burglary.

Eaton: Report of a burglary from a barn whereby an item of value was taken.

Bottesford: Theft of 4x4 overnight.

#### Targeted Priority Activity Continued (summary):

- Stolen vehicle recovered, 2 individuals arrested.
- Drink Driver taken off the road and charged.

- Investigation carried out in relation to the theft of a catalytic converter.

- Increased patrols surrounding the increase in ASB. Ongoing investigation into identifying those responsible with a view of educating and diverting behaviours, as well as entering them onto the incremental approach.

- Collaborative partnership work carried out to jointly tackle neighbourhood issues reported to the beat team.

- Numerous stop checks of vehicles during the later hours, namely 4x4 and vehicles towing trailers or farm equipment.
