What matters to you

We have listened to you and the concerns you raised and prioritised the following in October 2023

Priority 1: Theft from motor vehicle

You said: Theft from motor vehicles are a concern to you.

What we are going to do: Targeted patrols and partnership working with National Car Parks to help deter offences.

Priority 2: Cycle Thefts

You Said: Cycle thefts were an issue on the beat.

What we are going to do: Partnership working with De Montfort University and Leicester Royal Infirmary to help deter theft of cycles. On going engagements events, including: bike registering in affected areas.

Priority 3: Burglaries

You said: As the darker nights come in you said that burglaries were a concern.

What we are going to do: Street consultations to educate, help reduce and prevent burglaries.

What we have done #yousaidwedid

- Partnership working with Housing, issuing Acceptable Behaviour Contracts to residents who have been causing anti-social behaviour.
- Continuing high visibility patrols in in key locations, including: Castle Gardens and Nelson Mandela Park regarding Antisocial Behaviour.
- Door knocks across several streets on the beat in relation to ongoing anti-social behaviour, signing residents up to Neighbourhood Link. This helped inform the new priorities that were set (above).
- Engagements at De Montfort University for Freshers week, registering bikes and signing students up for Neighbourhood Link
- Supported Project Search with inputs into safety awareness, helping young adults into employment.



What we have done #yousaidwewdid

- Officers have patrolled open spaces and made use of the Public Space Protection Order to tackle Anti Social Behaviour. We have seen a decrease but please continue to report issues to use so we can allocate our patrols in the right area.
