<p>Anti social behaviour including e-scooters electric bikes, environmental, targeted or nuisance behaviour from individuals or groups.</p>	<p>Asda—youths throwing items and causing issues with security and staff, this has been ongoing. They have now been banned and the beat team are looking into any offences which may have occurred.</p>
<p>Drugs is a priority, this includes drug use in public spaces as well as reports of drug use in dwellings, drug driving and any intelligence concerning selling and distributing and education around drug use.</p>	<p>In the past few weeks we have received numerous amount of intelligence including drugs and modern slavery, a drink driver and a drug driver. This information is placed into our computer systems and helps us when we apply for Warrants or during any stop searches.</p>

News

Patrols have been conducted on Narborough Park over the last few weeks in relation to youths causing Anti social behaviour near the memorial, outside the Council offices. This includes drinking, littering, pulling down branches and causing issues for local residents, the team are awaiting CCTV to Identify the group causing concern.

We have had reports in Enderby of vehicles not displaying trade plates correctly and the misuse of these, the beat team have contacted trading standards and the DVLA have also been informed, enquires are ongoing.

We have visited the local Narborough Beavers group last month as requested and talked about road safety and gave out some road safety goodies, they were very happy and a



very well behaved group, thank you for letting us attend.

PCSO Dan and PC Clare held a beat surgery at TG Jones at Fosse Park, engaging with members of the public and offering safety advice. Several sign ups were completed for Neighbourhood Link, our free police messaging service which keeps residents up to date with what is happening in their area and future events.

PCSO Sarah attended the Annual parish meeting held by the chairman of the parish council in Narborough. This was attended by other community groups and member of the public, to discuss all parish affairs and concerns and to give out advice and tools from all groups to help our parish residents. This event was very well attended by the public, Councillors and volunteers and was very well organised. Lots of crime prevention items given out with advice and updates to any of the local issues raised. Thank you for the invite, these kind of events are extremely beneficial to the local Neighbourhood Police team.
