We have listened to you and the concerns you raised and will prioritise the following,

What you have said	Action taken
You have stated that Anti-Social Behaviour is a concern within the Charnwood East area.	Patrols have continued in the Checkland Road area regarding ASB – including motorbikes being driven in an antisocial manner and drug taking. Patrols have also taken place in the evenings on Wanlip Road in Syston regarding noise and use of nitrous oxide .
The shopping centre historically has an increase in ASB and reported crimes during the months of July and August	A beat surgery took place at Marks and Spencers and further surgery's will be planned for this location. We have assisted in the investigation of theft stores which has resulted in the arrest and remand of two 2 prolific shop lifters. High vis patrols have continued at the location
You have raised concerns regarding people using and dealing drugs.	Work continues to develop intelligence regarding drug dealing. High visibility patrols have taken place in areas reported to be used for drug use - including Central Park Syston and Checkland Road. We continue to work with our partner agencies to ensure a joint approach is employed.

Thank you to those who came to our beat engagements this month. Thank you to those for raising their concerns and for all the positive feedback.

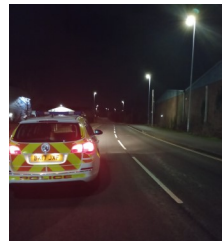


On going hi-visibility patrols are being conducted around the following locations for anti-social behaviour and drug dealing.

On going marked patrols around Thurmaston Retail Park and Rayns Way in relation to the car cruise that takes place weekly around Thurmaston.



Over the last month, there has been a high volume of reports regarding anti-social behaviour taking place at Queniborough Lodge in Queniborough. This anti-social behaviour is ranging from criminal damage, fires, explorers and youths causing a nuisance.

Queniborough Lodge is a derelict site with over 55 acres of land. This site is very dangerous and consists of old businesses/workshops which still contains big machinery. This site is not stable and is very dangerous for members of the public to gain access to it.

This site is a gold mine for explorers and for young children to adventure through however, this site is extremely dangerous and somebody could get seriously hurt. We as a beat team are trying our best to get this site secured by the new owners. We are currently patrolling parts of the location which is safe to do so. This is currently a popular spot for youths to go.

Parents and guardians, please can you ensure you know where your children are going, who they are with and that they are safe. Make sure they are not entering this derelict site!

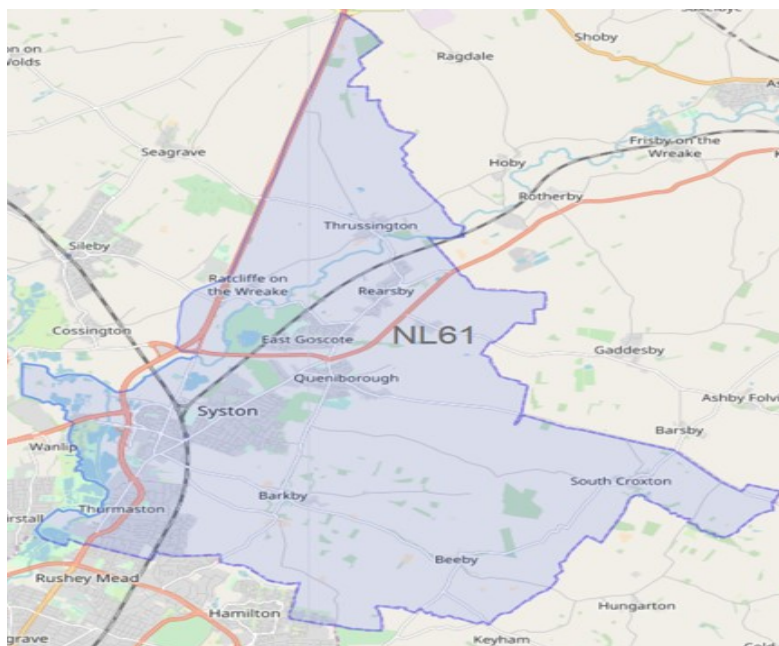
