#YouSaid - What matters to you

We have listened to you and the concerns you raised and the following:

Your Concern:

We understand that **drug use, drug dealing**, and the associated criminal activity are causing significant concern within the community.

Our Response:

We are committed to addressing these issues by working closely with local residents, partner agencies, and community organisations to gather information, target offenders, and provide appropriate support where needed. Your safety and confidence remain our priority, and we will continue to take proactive steps to reduce harm and improve the quality of life for everyone in the area.

Your Concern: **Anti-social behaviour** is a major concern for many residents on the beat.

Our Response: We are committed to identifying those responsible and addressing their behaviour through the Anti-Social Behaviour (ASB) incremental approach. This ensures proportionate and consistent action is taken, with the aim of reducing harm and improving community safety.

Your Concern: **Speeding and road safety** across the beat have been highlighted as key concerns by members of the community.

Our Response: With the Road Safety Partnership, the speed enforcement vehicle continues to be utilised to priority locations across the beat. This targeted approach aims to deter speeding, improve driver behaviour, and enhance overall road safety for all road users.

#WeDid - What we are doing

Neighbourhood Policing Update- It's been a busy few weeks for your local neighbourhood team, with officers and PCSOs working across Melton and the surrounding villages to support residents, **tackle local concerns**, and keep our communities **safe**.

High-Visibility Patrols

Officers have continued to carry out high-visibility foot and vehicle patrols across Melton Town South, providing reassurance to residents and helping to deter crime and anti-social behaviour.

Safeguarding Vulnerable People

Protecting vulnerable members of our community remains a priority. We have completed several safeguarding visits and worked closely with partner agencies to ensure appropriate support is in place where needed.

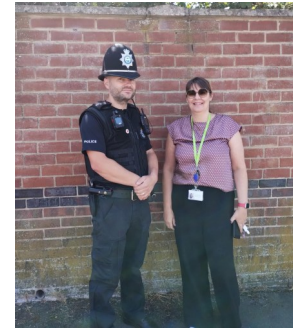

Supporting Operational Policing

Due to operational demand, officers have regularly assisted response colleagues at a number of live incidents. This has included assisting with arrests in relation to reports of domestic assaults, violent offences and incidents involving weapons, as well as transporting prisoners to custody and carrying out associated enquiries.

Safeguarding Vulnerable People

Protecting vulnerable individuals remains a key priority. During this period, officers have worked closely with Social Services, housing providers and partner agencies to support individuals believed to be at risk of exploitation, financial abuse and cuckooing. Safeguarding visits and welfare checks have been completed to ensure appropriate support and intervention are in place.

Community Engagement & Partnership Working

The team has continued to engage with residents through beat surgeries, patch walks and reassurance visits across Melton Town South. Joint visits have been conducted with Melton Borough Council, Nottingham Community Housing Association and Anti-Social Behaviour Officers to discuss issues raised by residents and identify practical solutions to local concerns.

Tackling Anti-Social Behaviour

Anti-social behaviour remains a priority for the beat team. Officers have worked with partner agencies and housing providers to investigate reports of nuisance behaviour, neighbour disputes and suspected drug-related activity. Targeted patrols and follow-up visits have been carried out to address concerns and provide reassurance to affected residents.

Road Safety & Vehicle Enforcement

Following reports from local residents, officers seized an untaxed vehicle linked to concerns around anti-social driving and arranged for an abandoned vehicle to be removed from the area. Patrols have also been conducted on Burton Road and Norfolk Drive in response to concerns regarding Heavy Goods Vehicles using local roads. Additionally, officers assisted with traffic management on the A607 for several hours following a fallen tree blocking the carriageway.

Investigations & Crime Enquiries

A significant amount of time has been dedicated to progressing ongoing investigations. This has included conducting house-to-house enquiries following reports of burglary, reviewing CCTV footage, obtaining witness statements, carrying out victim visits and gathering evidence relating to thefts, road traffic collisions and other reported incidents.

Intelligence Development

Officers have continued to gather and submit intelligence relating to criminality and community concerns within the beat area. Information provided by residents remains invaluable in helping us build a clearer picture of local issues and direct resources where they are needed most.

Visible Patrols & Reassurance

High-visibility foot and vehicle patrols have been conducted across Melton Town South, including patrols in the Pork Pie Way area and locations identified through community feedback. These patrols help deter criminality, address anti-social behaviour and provide opportunities for residents to engage directly with their local neighbourhood officers.

Behind the Scenes

Alongside visible policing, officers have completed numerous crime reports, intelligence logs, safeguarding referrals and investigative updates. Work has also been carried out to produce community newsletters, update neighbourhood policing pages and distribute Neighbourhood Link messages to keep residents informed about local policing activity.

Thank you to everyone who has spoken with us during patrols, attended community engagements, reported concerns and shared information. Your support helps us identify issues, safeguard vulnerable people, tackle anti-social behaviour and continue making Melton Town South a safer place to live, work and visit.

Safeguarding & Welfare

Officers responded to **mental health-related welfare concerns**, including submitting a **safeguarding report** with the individual's consent.

Station Duties

- The team also supported the **front enquiry office**, handling a wide range of public enquiries including criminal reports, intelligence sharing, and general queries.

- We continue to deal with local issues such as Anti-social behaviour and safeguard vulnerable residents and cuckooing victims as and when we identify concerns.
- Our work is ongoing with local schools including engagement events.
- And lastly as 'Dedicated Neighbourhood Officers' we continue to work on and try find solutions with neighbour disputes. We also support our response colleagues and cover the front enquiry office too.
