What matters to you

From information collated from local surveys, beat knowledge, intelligence and reports to Leicestershire Police, the following areas have been highlighted as priorities within the community:

- **Priority 1: Anti-Social Behaviour (ASB)**

You said: Anti-social behaviour around Dragonfly Walk, particularly during evenings and weekends.

We have responded to reports of Anti-Social Behaviour in and around the area and we have increased our patrols in that area to deter and/or identify and deal with those responsible.

- **Priority 2: Drugs**

You said: Offences relating to drugs remain a concern in the area and so we are seeking to develop intelligence in this area, which will hopefully allow us to take enforcement action.

- **Priority 3: Anti-Social Behaviour (ASB)**
