News

PCSO Sarah had a number of busy shifts last month. Incidents were reported in relation to vehicle obstructions and neighbour disputes in Littlethorpe. Sarah visited and spoke to all the parties concerned and will be working with our partner agencies to deal with the issues raised. An incident was reported in relation to issues around school parking, all parties were spoken to and this has now been resolved. We have conducted patrols around Kipling drive and Stewart Avenue, Enderby after we were notified about obstructions and bad parking, we're happy to say over the last week there have been no issues at all. Sarah has also conducted patrols around Cross Street outside Morrison's in Enderby, after a few calls were received about vehicles that were parked on the junction and on the double yellow lines, those drivers were advised and moved on.



While out and about on their beats PCSO's Dan and Danny attended the Enderby Civic Centre & Library for a Beat Surgery along with the District & Parish Councillors. Although they were there for only an hour, the attention this event received was positive and the local residents of the community met them with warm welcomes and plenty to discuss. On one of the topics of parking, one vehicle in particular was raised having reported being abandoned and with no tax. Upon conducting further enquiries it turned out the vehicle indeed held no road tax, no insurance and the keeper was not local, with that, we enforced our DVLA powers and we recovered the vehicle for being abandoned on the public highway.

A female attempted to steal items amounting to just over £500.00 at ASDA. Security staff at ASDA managed to stop her outside the exit. After escorting her to the holding area, they emptied out 2 big carrier bags into an empty trolley to see what items she had attempted to steal. This items included coffee pods, shampoo and other health care items. The female was charged using the new 'straight charge procedure' which was bought in in February. This allows Police Officers to charge suspects immediately for certain offenses without prior consultation with the Crown Prosecution Service.
