What matters to you

We have revised our beat priorities as of October 2025 to reflect what we have been told concerns the community most.

- Priority 1: Commercial Burglaries:
 - **What we did:** 2 Males were arrested under suspicion of attempting to break into a café on Queens Road. One was released and another was arrested for further offences.
- Priority 2: Victoria Park Car Park vehicle ASB.
 - **What we did:** Our Road Traffic Policing team have been persisting with visits to the Granville Road car park—further S.165 seizures were issued and the local team have been continuing with proactive work in conjunction with Leicester City Council.
- **Priority 3: Vehicle Crime** We will carry on with our initiatives to remind and re-educate about vehicle security over the winter months.
 - **What we Did:** We are restarting a force-wide initiative of Safer Streets Winter—This will include grass-roots policing to tackle crime at a street level.

Other Local News

- Clarendon Park Fair: Your local team will be in attendance at the Fair on December 7th
- Safer Streets—Winter: Echoing the work done throughout summer by beat teams focusing on street level criminality and ASB. The same initiative is being reintroduced from December to February. This will mean an increased presence in specific areas to deter crime at its infancy—with a focus on retail crime and substance misuse in areas that are a cause for concern in the Clarendon Park area.
- Joint agency working—Leicestershire Police, Leicester City council and Leicester University have been having frequent meetings to share information to streamline concerns that have been brought forward, from issues with individuals in the area to parking issues on Victoria Park Road. This will be ongoing.
