#YouSaidWeDid - What matters to you

Priority 1: Anti-social Behaviour in and around Braunstone Park, Cort Crescent and Gallards Hill

You said: Anti-Social Behaviour in and around Braunstone Park continues as a priority concern from the community. With Halloween and Bonfire night approaching, the team will continue to concentrate on this location.

We Did: The team continue to conduct high visibility patrols on Braunstone park and the surrounding area. The location is also a hot spot area for the nightly ASB car. This has so far resulted in a reduced number of calls regarding ASB at the location. The team are also exploring some additional funding that could potentially enhance the area further. Watch this space!!

Priority 2: Road Safety

You Said: From Community Surveys and Feedback on Neighbourhood Link, road safety has been highlighted to be a local concern. We will continue to concentrate on speeding concerns and anti social behaviour caused by e bikes, e scooters and off road motorbikes.

We Did: The team have now conducted multiple Op Pedalfast operations in Braunstone and Rowley Fields. This has resulted in 39 e scooters and 38 e bikes being seized since 22nd August. It has also resulted in a stolen motorbike being recovered, a stolen bike being recovered and multiple arrests for other offences.

Your feedback has been very positive and we will continue to take illegal vehicles off the roads and footpaths. The team have also executed our first tester speed enforcement operation on Gooding Avenue. Again, this has produced good feedback from the community and will look at upping the number of those operations.

Priority 3: Anti-social Behaviour (Drug related)

You Said: From the Surveys on Neighbourhood Link you have told us that drug dealing and usage at locations across the Braunstone and Rowley Fields area is a concern.

We Did: For the year to date, the team have executed 10 Misuse of Drugs Act warrants this year. This is based on the information that you, the community tell us about. This is in addition to multiple arrests that occur for drugs related offences across the beat. The team are currently in the process of obtaining further warrants, so watch this space!!

Good news

Here is a round up of November;

- Operation Pedalfast have continued in Braunstone and Rowley Fields. We are up to a total of 38 e-scooters and 39 e-bikes—totalling 77!
- A full closure order has been granted on Bennett Walk after multiple complaints of drug use, drug dealing and related anti-social behaviour.
- PCSOs Julie and Beth recovered a vehicle on Hopefield Road after being seen in suspicious circumstances.
- PC Chris—from the City Centre team, and PCSO Beth had a vehicle make off from them during a stop check. An area search revealed the vehicle had been abandoned on Ainsdale Road. Further investigation has shown that the driver has no driving licence and no insurance.
- A Section 8 Misuse of Drugs Act warrant was conducted at an address on Lambert Road. The action was taken following information provided by you, the public, about suspected drug-related activity. The investigation is ongoing, and we will continue to share updates where we can.
- A second Section 8 Misuse of Drugs Act warrant was also conducted on Pilkington Road. Again, this is from information provided by members of the public. The investigation continues.
- PCSO Geoff spotted a suspicious looking vehicle on Woodshawe Rise. On further checks, the vehicle was on false plates and turned out to be a stolen vehicle from early 2025.
- PCSOs recovered a vehicle causing an obstruction on the junction of Nutfield Road and Imperial Avenue.
