What matters to you

We have identified the following priorities which are in place as of 1st October 2025:

- **Priority 1: ASB**

You Said: We are aware of issues with youths causing anti-social behaviour in the area of Hillsborough Road and Thurcroft Close. We will be working to tackle this issue moving forward.

We Did: Officers have continued to deter anti-social behaviour in the area. One youth has been arrested for causing a number of issues around the estate, including at the Co-Op on Hillsborough Road. They have been interviewed and bailed with conditions. Investigation work is continuing.

- **Priority 2: Drug Dealing**

You Said: We continue to carry this priority forward into October as you have advised us this remains a serious issue. We will continue to tackle those who blight the local area with drugs.

We Did: Two warrants have been completed recently by local officers at addresses on HILLSBOROUGH CLOSE and GRANGE DRIVE. An arrest was made for drug offences and our investigations continue. We will also be working closely with Leicester City Council where addresses are identified as being involved in drug supply where Closure Orders may be viable. Further to this, a male was arrested for drug offences in the STURDEE ROAD area and has been bailed with a number of conditions in place.

- **Priority 3: Shoplifting**

You Said: There has been an increase in retail theft over the summer months at local stores.

We Did: The beat team is looking at working closely with local business, particularly the Co-Op stores on the beat who appear to suffer most from repeat shoplifters. Visits to each Co-Op store are scheduled in with local PCSOs to look at how we can work together to ensure regular offenders are being reported and dealt with more effectively. One individual is subject to a CBO (Criminal Behaviour Order), which is a court order for persistent offenders to aid in preventing them continuing these actions.

- Now that the darker nights are here, we usually see an increase in burglaries and vehicle crime. Your local team will be out patrolling hotspot locations, but below are just a few of the simple steps you can take to reduce your chances of being a victim of crime:
 - ⇒ Keep doors and windows locked. Take the key out of the lock.
 - ⇒ Prevent easy access to your home with locked gates or fencing.
 - ⇒ Move/remove items which can provide easier access to windows, such as bins and garden furniture.
 - ⇒ Keep ladders out of sight and ensure sheds, garages and outbuildings are locked.
