### What matters to you

We have revised our beat priorities as of October 2025 to reflect what we have been told concerns the community most.

Priority 1: Commercial Burglaries:

**What we did:** Throughout late 2024/2025, focus was shifted to the Queens Road/Clarendon Park area of the beat. We will be aiming to do the same for the winter months of 2025 with increased police presence, overnight patrols and in the event of an uptake—quicker actioning of gathering evidence.

• Priority 2: Victoria Park Car Park vehicle ASB.

**What we did:** A case has been ongoing to manage issues at the Victoria Park car park—to date we have a register of vehicles that have had actions taken against them and have been added to PNS—Police National Computer

• **Priority 3: Vehicle Crime** - We will carry on with our initiatives to remind and re-educate about vehicle security over the summer months.

**What we Did:** 4 Thefts from motor Vehicles were recorded in September on the beat as a whole, we will continue with patrols, advise drivers where possible and establish patterns of offending to pre-empt offences taking place.

  The turnout was overwhelmingly positive with over 40 bikes marked in the time allocated—More dates of open events will be published
