You the local community have said that the following 3 priorities matter to you

Priority 1: Drug Dealing **What we're doing:** The team has been actively gathering intelligence and engaging with the local community to better understand the issues surrounding drug activity. We are committed to targeting individuals involved in drug dealing and will be working closely with our partners to take firm and effective action against them.

Priority 2: Retail Theft **What we're doing:** The beat team will prioritize working with local retailers to ensure that offences of theft are reported promptly and that all necessary evidence is gathered efficiently.

This proactive approach will support timely investigations and enable us to take decisive action against persistent offenders. By strengthening these working partnerships, we aim to improve community safety and reduce repeat incidents through consistent enforcement.

Priority 3: Road Safety/Speeding **What we're doing:** Officers continue to prioritise road safety by conducting targeted speed checks across several key locations within the beat area.

These include Hathern Road, Anson Road, Loughborough Road, and Cambridge Street—areas identified through community feedback and traffic data as needing increased enforcement.

The ongoing operations aim to deter speeding, enhance driver awareness, and ensure safer conditions for all road users.

Community Engagement

The team conduct regular beat surgeries at various venues across the beat area to engage with the community, address concerns, and provide support.
