We have listened to you and the concerns you raised and will prioritise the following,

What you have said	Action taken
You have stated that Anti-Social Behaviour is a concern within the Charnwood East area.	Patrols have continued on Checkland road and Thurmaston retail park, with 2 beat surgeries taking place at the latter, Patrols in the evening have also taken place in Central Park and we will continue to work with partner agencies to tackle people causing ASB at specific locations.
The shopping centre historically has an increase in ASB and reported crimes during the months of July and August	We have continued to conduct high visibility patrols and work with the stores at the shopping centre. We have also patrolled the location at key times to reduce ASB caused by the car cruise.
You have raised concerns regarding people using and dealing drugs.	Work continues to develop intel regarding drug dealing. High visibility patrols have taken place in areas reported to be used for drug use- including Central Park, Syston and Checkland Road. . We continue to work with our partner agencies to ensure a joint approach is employed.

The males who were believed to have cannabis were searched, where a small amount of cannabis were found and seized. Both males were issued a Community Resolution and sent on their way.


