What matters to you

We have identified the following priorities which are in place from 1st July 2025:

Priority 1: ASB

You Said: You have concerns around the issues we have had in previous years with off road bikes on the recreation ground and other open spaces.

We Did: We are well aware of the seasonal (summer) issue with off road bikes on the recreation ground and other open spaces around the local area. Local officers will be stepping up enforcement and education efforts to limit this issue through the summer months ahead so that the areas can be enjoyed by everyone.

Priority 2: Drug Dealing

You Said: We continue to carry this priority forward over the summer months as you have advised us this remains a serious issue. We will continue to tackle those who blight the local area with drugs.

We Did: Patrols have continued around identified hotspot areas. We have continued to act upon intelligence received to us and there is enforcement action imminent against a number of properties. We welcome any reports with information regarding drugs and this will be followed up on by your local beat team.

Priority 3: Robbery

You Said: There have been several robberies in the area of Swinford Avenue which we are aware have caused some concern in the community.

We Did: We are continuing to build intelligence and have been carrying out foot patrols in the area to deter further issues,
