Reports of drug dealing and using at several addresses on the beat, attracting undesirables to the location and often resulting in ASB (Anti-Social Behaviour) and disorder at the addresses.	See below
Speeding of vehicles along several roads on the beat, breaches of weight restrictions and bridge strikes all lead to a feeling amongst the community that road safety is an issue.	See below for update.
Theft of and theft from motor vehicles continues to be a problem over the Greater Hinckley beat area.	Targeted patrols have continued around problem areas showing a reduction in theft from and theft of motor vehicles.

News

Officers from the Earl Shilton & Barwell, Burbage and Hinckley Beat Teams recently worked alongside Roads Policing Unit (RPU) and Response officers to carry out a proactive traffic operation across Earl Shilton, Barwell, Hinckley and Burbage. The operation focused on keeping our roads safe and addressing offences that put other road users at risk.



Results from the day included: 3 speeding tickets issued on the A47 Clickers Way, 4 tickets issued for not wearing a seatbelt, 1 ticket issued for a vehicle displaying a ghost plate and having no MOT, 1 vehicle issued with a prohibition notice due to an insecure load posing a danger to others, stop searches conducted under s23 Misuse of Drugs Act (no items found), offences identified including no MOT and no rear registration plate and intelligence submitted relating to a vehicle linked to an outstanding suspect. Road safety is everyone's responsibility. Whether it's speeding, not wearing a seatbelt, or using unsafe vehicles, these offences can have serious consequences. We will continue to carry out enforcement and engagement activity across the area to keep our communities safe.

Intelligence led patrols have been conducted around Hinckley in relation to Drugs, both the use of and dealing. Officers have submitted intelligence and are developing this further.

For our road safety priority we conducted a Fatal 4 operation with our Roads Policing Unit. 32 offences were logged within a 3 hour period, primarily mobile phone use and not wearing a seatbelt. 1 male driver was arrested for driving while under the influence.

As part of Operation Sceptre, a knife test purchase operation was carried out in Hinckley. We're pleased to report that most of the stores tested, challenged appropriately and requested ID, demonstrating strong commitment to keeping our community safe. The premises that failed will be dealt with robustly! A big thank you to the retailers and staff who continue to uphold their Challenge 25 policies and help prevent knives from getting into the wrong hands. Your vigilance makes a real difference.
