We have revised our beat priorities as of April 2026 to reflect what we have been told concerns the community most.

- **Priority 1: Anti-Social Behaviour and Public Nuisance**

**What we did:** Parks, open spaces and greens will be under the microscope during the warmer months. We encourage reporting of misuse of public spaces for issues such as Street Drinking, Vehicle related ASB or any other issues that the community at large find as a concern.

- **Priority 2: Theft and Shoplifting**


**What we did:** Shops on our area have taken great strides in securing their stock and property during the winter months. PCs Gray and Rogers are new additions to the South Leicester team that are tasked with tackling shop thefts and street level crimes.

- **Priority 3: Violence and Night Time economy harm.**

**What we Did:** Trends have shown that violent behaviour can creep up during warmer months. This may be attributed to more alcohol consumption and good weather drawing people out to public open spaces. In anticipation, officers on South Leicester will be carrying out covert work in areas that may be more likely to experience this issue.

## Other Local News

- EID Festival—Very limited issues during Eid on Victoria Park this year. A couple of cases of low level public order and a single report of an assault which was swiftly dealt with. Thanks to the Stewards and the Security team for their diligence.
- Cap Man—The colloquially known Cap Man has come to our attention again. There has been some background work that has been continuous since he came to our attention—please be assured we are maintaining frequent contact with him and the recent incidents will be notified.
- Burglary—The break-in at JEFF hardware on Queens Road led to an arrest being made within 24 hours. The suspect has been charged and is awaiting their day in court.
