### What matters to you

We have listened to you and the concerns you raised and will prioritise the following,

Priority 1 - What you have said:

You have told us that anti-social behaviour (ASB) is a concern in your community, particularly involving the use of quad bikes and groups of rowdy youths gathering in parks and recreational areas.

#### **Action taken**

In response, we continue to work closely with partner agencies including Charnwood Borough Council (CBC), who are liaising with city council counterparts and the neighbouring NE11 Beat Team to address ongoing issues related to illegal bike use and ASB in Thorpebury in the Limes. Joint enforcement options and long-term preventative measures are being explored to deter illegal vehicle access. Patrols at the location have continued, resulting in the seizure of a motorbike. Submitted CCTV footage is being reviewed with the intention of issuing Section 59 warnings or vehicle seizures where appropriate. Enquiries are ongoing to identify the ownership of land being used, with a view to issuing a Community Protection Warning (CPW). We are also awaiting a response from developers regarding the feasibility of blocking off paths currently used for illegal access.

Priority 2 -

#### What you have said:

The community has also stated that speeding and parking issues are a concern at various locations throughout the Charnwood East area.

#### **Action taken**

In response, a speed operation was recently carried out on Main Street in South Croxton, with further ad-hoc speed checks continuing at sites identified by the team. Officers have also engaged with Bishop Ellis School, delivering road safety advice to pupils and staff. Additionally, the team has assisted with road safety incidents, including support at the scene of a broken-down vehicle, helping to ensure the safety of all road users.

Priority 3 -

#### What you have said:

Retail theft has been identified as a growing concern within the beat, with several stores being repeatedly targeted.

#### **Action taken**

In response, officers have taken proactive steps to address the issue, including the collection of CCTV footage to support ongoing investigations and assist in identifying those responsible. Patrols have been increased at key locations, providing a visible and reassuring presence. Officers continue to engage with store staff, holding beat surgeries at retail sites to strengthen partnerships and gather valuable intelligence to help prevent further incidents.

### **The Beat Team News**

Everyday your local beat team are conducting marked Police car patrols through the villages of Charnwood East. These villages are Syston, Thurmaston, Thrussington, East Goscote, Ratcliffe on the Wreake, Barkby, Barbky Thorpe, Beeby, Rearsby, Hamilton Lea, Queniborough, South Croxton and Thorpebury in the Limes.

The local beat team conducted a beat surgery at Coscto in Thurmaston, where they were joined by Thurmaston Councillors and other local residents. Issues and concerns were raised and discussed throughout the surgery.



Over the past month, the Charnwood Beat Team, with support from traffic units, has maintained a high-visibility presence at Thurmaston Retail Park in response to concerns around antisocial behaviour. This proactive approach has included regular patrols and, on one occasion, the issuing of a dispersal order to address disruptive activity. We continue to work closely with retail park management and the local authority to develop a sustainable, long-term solution that promotes safety and reassurance for both businesses and visitors to the area.

PCSO 6024 and 6098 had the wonderful opportunity to visit Bishop Ellis Catholic Primary school in Thurmaston as part of our ongoing commitment to building positive relationships within the community. They spent time engaging with the students, answering their questions, and sharing important safety tips.

They also met with the headteacher to discuss any concerns or issues that the school community may be facing. Establishing a strong relationship with local schools is crucial.



We worked with colleagues from our Response and NPT teams to dismantle this cannabis grow situated in a residential property. Concerns were raised by the local community which led to us uncovering the grow.



PCSO 6098 conducted her monthly beat engagement at East Goscote Library, engaging with the local residents.

Beat surgery was conducted on Hill top road in the Thorpebury in the limes estate. Engaging with residents in relation to the ASB from motorbikes.


