# What matters to you

From information collated from local surveys, beat knowledge, intelligence and reports to Leicestershire Police, the following areas have been highlighted as priorities within the community:

Priority 1: Anti-social behaviour, including rowdy behaviour and drug use, in the area of Gilmorton Avenue.

You said: Anti-social behaviour around Gilmorton Ave, particularly during evenings and weekends.

We did: We have only been working on this issue for a couple of weeks. During this time, we have increased our presence in the area and we recently disturbed a group that were suspiciously close to a stolen motorbike, which we subsequently recovered.

Priority 2: Vehicle crime in the area of Morcom Drive

You said: There has been a reported increase in vehicle crime In the area of Morcom Drive

We did: We are conducting patrols in the area and will be giving crime prevention advice in the area. If you see anything suspicious or have any information please report this via 101 or crime stoppers.

Priority 3: Anti-social behaviour and vehicle crime in the area of Park Hill Drive

You said: Anti-Social behaviour in and around Park Hill Drive
