## #YouSaidWeDid - What matters to you

### Beat priorities focus on the issues that matter most within our communities.

These priorities are shaped by you, and they give us the opportunity to address the concerns that affect your daily life.

We are currently in consultation with regards to our next set of quarterly beat priorities and look forward to sharing these with you in our next months newsletter.

**Priority 1)** To reduce parking related issues on Station Road and surrounding roads in Kegworth.

**Actions Taken)** Since the last update, continued patrols have been conducted around the affected areas with no obstructions discovered. We've also seen a decrease in reports coming in from members of the public.

**Priority 2)** To target illegal off-road motorbikes, specifically within Castle Donington.

**Action Taken)** We are continuing to work with SEGRO to combat this issue and pro-active patrols are still being conducted where possible. A group of off-road bikers have been identified and the team are progressing with all necessary steps in order to prosecute the riders to stop them from returning.

**Priority 3)** Operation Barrack - To reduce theft from lorries at Moto-Services, Castle Donington.

**Action Taken)** Over the past quarter, the dedicated work carried out at Moto Services, has resulted in a noticeable decrease in reported thefts from lorries and related suspicious activity incidents.

## Burglary—Crime Prevention Advice

We're reminding residents to take a few simple steps to help keep homes and valuables secure. Burglars look for easy opportunities — taking small precautions can make a big difference.

### Secure Your Home

- **Lock doors and windows** even when you're at home or only popping out for a moment.
- Keep **keys out of sight** away from letterboxes and windows.
- If you have them, use **UPVC door multi point locks** — lift the handle and lock with the key.
- Consider installing **Home CCTV** systems such as **Ring Doorbells (or similar)**

### Make Your Home Look Occupied

- Leave a **light on a timer** if you're out after dark.
- Use **external security lighting** where possible.
- Avoid leaving your home in darkness for long periods.

### Vehicle Security

- Don't leave car or house keys **within reach of doors**
- Make sure to **lock** your car
- Remove all **valuables**
- Consider **steering locks**, signal blocking pouches (Faraday pouches), and secure parking.
