What matters to you

Priority 1: Burglaries.

You said: That your neighbourhood is prone to burglary.

We did: We have been on the beat posting leaflets to educate local residents about keeping your home safe and secure. We will continue to conducts high visible patrols and maintain a strong policing presence in the community, we will also be holding beat engagements for crime prevention tips.

Priority 2: ASB.

You said: ASB and drug use in the area of Pendlebury Drive is a problem.

We did: The team have continued to conduct patrols in these areas to deter issues and try and identify suspects. A beat patch walk will be taking place on the 01/04/25 at 14:30 with partner agencies to discuss these problems and we will be working together to try and resolve these issues.

Priority 3: Road safety.

You said: The use of E-scooters and e-bikes was a problem across the beat.

We Did: Your beat team will be conducting road safety Ops to deter and educate these riders at targeted areas that are reported to us. If there are any other areas that you would like us target then please let us know.
