Priority 1: Anti-Social Behaviour

- You Said: We have had an increase in reports of anti-social behaviour in and around the area of The Dales. Residents have been reporting youths throwing items at houses, and knocking on doors.
- Our Action: There has been a huge decrease in issues within the Dales. Due to this, we have updated our priorities which can be found on our Leicestershire Police website.


Priority 2: Anti-Social Behaviour

- **Our Action:** The Problem Management Plan has been successful so far. There has been multiple arrests. A decrease in issue with youths and a number of warning letters issued.


Priority 3: Heathley Park
