We have listened to your concerns and prioritised the following in December 2025:

These Priorities will be reviewed Jan 2026

Priority 1: Anti-Social Behaviour

- **You Said:** We have had an increase in reports of anti-social behaviour in and around the area of The Dales. Residents have been reporting youths throwing items at houses, and knocking on doors.
- **Our Action:** There has been a huge decrease in issues within the Dales. Due to this, we have updated our priorities which can be found on our Leicestershire Police website.

Priority 2: Anti-Social Behaviour

- **You Said:** Retailers and security at the Beaumont Leys Shopping Centre have on-going problems with youths causing anti-social behaviour.
- **Our Action:** The Problem Management Plan has been successful so far. There has been multiple arrests. A decrease in issue with youths and a number of warning letters issued.

Priority 3: Heathley Park

- **You Said:** Concerns over an increase in thefts from motor vehicles, burglaries and anti-social behaviour.
- **Our Action:** The beat team have been carrying out regular high visibility patrols across the area. These are aimed to maintain community reassurance and deter criminal activity.
