I would like to share some recent updates from across West Leicester and highlight the work taking place to keep our communities safe.

It is with great sadness that I open this letter as we remember former West Leicester NPA Commander, DCI Deb Hubbard, who passed away from leukaemia recently. Her funeral was held on Tuesday and was well attended by colleagues, friends and family. She will be sorely missed and remains in the thoughts and memories of all those who worked alongside her during her time at West Leicester and in other areas of policing.

In operational news, tackling drug-related offending and the wider criminality linked to it remains a priority for West Leicester NPA. We continue to work closely with partner agencies to disrupt those causing harm. As part of this work, we recently secured a full Closure Order at an address on Chainama Close, helping to protect residents and address criminality and anti-social behaviour connected with the location.

We will shortly be launching our Community Confidence Survey. This will give residents an opportunity to share their views about local policing, feelings of safety and the issues that matter most in their communities. Your feedback will help us understand local concerns and shape our priorities. Please continue to monitor our social media channels for further information about the survey and how to take part.

Finally, I recently joined officers on foot patrol around Rally Park, which is identified as a hotspot location within our Problem Management Plan. These patrols allow us to speak directly with residents and focus activity where it is most needed. By working together with residents, partners and local organisations, we can continue to tackle crime, protect vulnerable people and make West Leicester safer for everyone.
