### Previous Beat Priorities Update – June 2026

- **Priority 1: Anti-Social Behaviour and Public Nuisance**

**What we did:** We have worked with LCC Parks and LCC CCTV to identify those who use vehicles in a Anti-Social manner and have been issued with section 59 warning, further enforcement work carried out by colleagues from our Traffic team.

- **Priority 2: Theft and Shoplifting**

**What we did:** Your local beat Officers have been engaging with local shops on Queens Road to prevent and lower shoplifting, PC Gray and PC Rodgers who are our dedicated officers for retail crime who successfully managed to arrest persons responsible for shop lifting at Sainsbury Store.

- **Priority 3: Violence and Night Time Economy Harm.**

**What we did:** Your local Beat team officers has engaged with local licensed premises as part of our safer night-time economy through visible patrols and with visits to local venues with partners.

### Clarendon Park Beat New Priorities Update – July 2026

We have revised our beat priorities to reflect the issues and concerns that matter most to our communities. These priorities are based on feedback gathered through community surveys and supported by police data.

#### **1. Working with local businesses to reduce retail theft and bring offenders to justice**

We will be working closely with local retailers to identify repeat offenders, conduct high-visibility patrols in key retail areas, provided crime prevention advice to businesses, and supported targeted operations to detect and prosecute those responsible for shop theft.

#### **2. Tackling anti-social behaviour on Victoria Park**

Increased patrols in open spaces, engaging with young people and local residents, respond to reports of anti-social behaviour, and work with partner agencies to address the causes of ongoing issues and improve public confidence.

#### **3. Identifying the most vulnerable members of our communities and ensuring they are signposted to the right support**

Identifying and engaging with vulnerable individuals through patrols and community contacts, carry out welfare checks where appropriate, and work with partner organisations to ensure people received access to safeguarding, housing, mental health, and other support services.
