What matters to you

From information collated from local surveys, beat knowledge, intelligence and reports to Leicestershire Police, the following areas have been highlighted as priorities within the community.

- **Priority 1: To develop drug intelligence in the area, which will allow us to take enforcement action.**

You said: Offences relating to drugs remain a concern in the area and we are seeking to develop intelligence and take positive, enforcement action.

We have responded to the reports and have completed street consultations and continue to develop intelligence and to take action with any offenders.

- **Priority 2: Anti-Social Behaviour and drug use in the area of Glenhills Boulevard.**

You said: Offences relating to drugs and Anti-Social Behaviour remain a concern in the area, so we are seeking to develop intelligence in this area, which will hopefully allow us to take enforcement action.

- **Priority 3: Drug use and the Anti-Social use of vehicles on the Aylestone Meadows and car park area.**

You said: Offences relating to drugs and Anti-Social use of vehicles on the Aylestone Meadows Car park and on the Aylestone Meadows.

We did: We have taken positive action and completed engagements with the public and continue to patrol the area to deter and/or identify and deal with those responsible.

Other Local News

Taking Positive Action with our Local Priorities.

We have taken positive action and completed street consultations, attended weekly social meetings in our previous Beat Priority areas and have now closed these as there have been no recent reports. By talking to local residents and engaging with many new residents in the area whilst listening to any Policing issues we now have the new Beat Priorities. We have signed some residents to our Neighbourhood Link, which is a free messaging service. Patrols will continue in all areas around the Beat.

After reports from the public of illegal motorbikes on the field areas on Braunston Lane East. Positive action has been taken and new Section 59 notices have been affixed as well as the area continuing to be patrolled. A stolen motor bike was located and recovered on the Aylestone Meadows.

We continue to attend the local social weekly meetings on the Beat to engage and listen to our residents who do not have access to Social Media about any policing concerns in the area and offer Crime Prevention Advice.
