Priority 1: Drug issues. What we are going to do-

Following recent success surrounding drug issues, the beat team have managed to effectively tackle a hotspot area for the supply of drugs. Despite this, the beat team continue to work closely with residents and the council to gather intelligence and seek out supply lines, if you think you have information that may help us, you can report this online, come and chat to us at a beat surgery, or crimestoppers is a great alternative if you wish to remain anonymous.

Priority 2: Nuisance parking surrounding schools. What we are going to do-

Whilst the Easter holidays have caused a drop in complaints surrounding parking, the beat team are fully aware once school returns parking will remain an issue for you. Please be assured the beat team are still conducting patrols when we can to ensure all are parked in a safe and considerate manner. The beat team aim to conduct patrols at the end of the school day, as this is when many of you informed us the parking is most dangerous and inconsiderate.

Priority 3: Retail theft. What we are going to do-

The beat team continues to work closely with retail premises regarding shoplifting. Regular patrols are conducted and staff are engaged with to ensure all is in order and any relevant CCTV is retrieved. The beat team aim to visit shops on a regular basis to provide reassurance and engage with staff.
