## **#YouSaid - What matters to you**

#### **NEW PRIORTIES**

You said that the following three priorities matter to you. Due to this, we have taken proportionate steps to target harden, educate and tackle the following priorities.

Priority 1) Anti Social Behaviour regarding off road bikes - Melrose estate, Greenhill estate, Barden hill, Ellistown

<u>Priority 2)</u> Targeted patrols on Anti Social Behaviour, focusing on Greenhill skate park, Waterworks rd and Cropston drive <u>Priority 3)</u> Road Safety – Parking & Speeding.

### #WeDid - What we have done

#### You said - Off road motorbikes are causing anti-social behaviour (ASB)

We Did - We managed to identify a number of bikes that have been regularly causing anti social behaviour in the Greenhill area. The beat team areattempting to identify the individuals on these bikes and retrospective action will be actioned. We have also maintained our high visibility patrols to deter any anti social behaviour and have issued a number of section 59 notices to individuals caught riding on public highways and places in an anti social way.

#### You said - Youths are causing issues around Greenhill

We Did - We had a number of reports concerning an abandoned building in the Greenhill area, this build was being broken into by local youths and with further damage being caused. Through a combination of local intelligence, CCTV opportunities, a number of youths were identified and issued with warning letters and there parents spoken too. North West Leicestershire District Council was also involved and were in contact with the property owner in securing the property. The property has now been fully secured.

You Said - Vehicles speeding in residential areas and parking particularly outside Schools are a problem.

We Did— Speed checks carried out on Pisca Lane, Heather / Ibstock.

Section one: A total of 60 vehicles were checked, with 1 found to be exceeding the speed limit. (50mph).

Section two: A total of 70 vehicles were checked, with 8 found to be exceeding the speed limit. (40mph).

Over the coming weeks further checks will be carried out at this location and others on the Bardon Beat.
