What matters to you

We have identified the following priorities which are in place as of 1st July 2025:

Priority 1: ASB

You Said: You have concerns around the issues we have had in previous years with off road bikes on the recreation ground and other open spaces.

We Did: A problem management plan is in place for the issue of off-road bikes, particularly noted as an issue on the Exchange Park. Local officers, including plain clothed officers, have continued to develop intelligence and take positive action against repeat offenders. A number of visits to addresses known for using bikes in an anti-social manner in the past have been completed and occupants at one address have been issued with a warning letter.

Priority 2: Drug Dealing

You Said: We continue to carry this priority forward over the summer months as you have advised us this remains a serious issue. We will continue to tackle those who blight the local area with drugs.

We Did: Local officers have continued to build intelligence around local addresses of interest. A number of warrants have been executed. As a result of one of these warrants, a closure order is being sought in collaboration with Leicester City Council against a persistent problem address in the area of Glenhills Boulevard.

Priority 3: Robbery

You Said: There have been several robberies in the area of Swinford Avenue which we are aware have caused some concern in the community.

We Did: We are continuing to build intelligence and have been carrying out foot patrols in the area. Plain clothed and uniformed patrols have been taking place across the estate and we are persistently patrolling areas which are linked to incidents of this type.
