What matters to you

We have listened to you and the concerns you raised and will prioritise the following from July 2025.

Priority 1: Drug issues. What we are going to do-

Drug issues still remain an issue for the beat team, the team have recently been listening to intelligence you have been providing us with and using this to identify problem areas and understand where more intelligence needs to be gathered. The team are currently identifying hotspot areas for drug activity and working on gathering more intelligence to proceed, but we need your help.. If you have any concerns, you can report them online, or anonymously via crimestoppers. Alternatively, you can find your local PCSO at any beat surgery if you wish to have a chat.

Priority 2: Speeding concerns around residential areas. What we are going to do-

You raised concerns and we listened. You have recently raised concerns to us regarding excessive speed in residential areas, as a result this remains one of our beat priorities, to monitor closely. The beat team have taken note of hotspot areas for excessive use of speed that you have told us about, and as a result speed operations are taking place where we (and you) feel are needed. We have been conducting high visibility patrols and parking up in hotspot areas to deter speeding. A speed gun operation was carried out on Belvoir Drive on the 17/06/25 where 50+ cars were monitored with none exceeding the speed limit.

Priority 3: Retail theft. What we are going to do-

The beat team continues to work closely with retail premises regarding shoplifting. We have recently experienced a spike in shop thefts, and as a result the beat team are working closely with staff to provide reassurance and deter shoplifters. CCTV enquiries are ongoing to identify those involved and prevent any further incidents.
