Burglary has been raised as a priority by residents. This will primarily be residential but there are a number of commercial premises in the NH19 area as well.	See below
General anti-social behaviour has been raised as a priority by local residents. This includes nuisance by youths at the Meridian Leisure Park	See below for updates
Road Safety including off road motorbikes, speeding and other general road safety issues raised as a priority by Neighbourhood Link	Its not always about ticketing and fines etc, so in addition we did an educational visit to the local scout group.

News

Here's a brief update from your local neighbourhood policing team. We've been out on patrol in areas highlighted by residents, providing a visible presence and engaging with members of the community and focussing on our green spaces.. We've issued a Community Resolution for a burglary offence; Issued a Section 59 warning to a vehicle being used in an anti-social manner and given two warning letters to youths, found breaking into an abandoned building, advising them of the consequences. We'd like to remind everyone, particularly young people, that entering abandoned buildings poses serious risks. These locations can be structurally unsafe, contain hazardous materials, and increase the chance of injury or worse. It is also a criminal offence and can lead to further action being taken. We're continuing to deal with anti-social behaviour, particularly in the evenings, and we'll take action where needed.

PCSO's Duane and Ryan had the unpleasant task of assisting with a dog bite incident recently with some pretty bad injuries. Thankfully the injured party is making a recovery. Whilst we wont comment on an ongoing investigation, please remember to keep your dog under control at all times. Not every person or dog wants to be approached by your friendly dog, so please be considerate and use a lead as appropriate.

We assisted in arresting an individual for indecent exposure. Whilst this investigation is still ongoing, we have referred the matter to the People Places Forum to progress a partnership approach, to manage those concerned. We have contacted the local schools to update them with regards to the situation.

PCSO Duane paid a visit to the 4th Leicester Scout Troop last month and had a chat with the Scouts about Internet Safety and Road Safety and also spoke about his own time in Scouting playing a game of Hot Rice!
