### News



A layby on the the A444 near to Sibson was the location of our latest Op Flux. Numerous vehicles were stopped. A driver was summonsed for driving without insurance and using their phone, another reported for summons for no insurance due to already having six points, a van without insurance was issued a Fixed Penalty Notice, a car transporter with 3.5t limit weighing in at 3920kg prohibited by the DVSA and reported, multiple stops for non-conforming registration plates with the worst offenders and repeat offenders given tickets, 5 other vehicles prohibited by DVSA with faults, which now require Full MOTs to be returned to the road and a van with 3.5t weight limit weighing in at 4250kg which was prohibited and reported.



A vehicle was recovered for parking at a crossing, I'm not sure the convenience of its location outweighed the 3 points on their license, £100 fine and the recovery fee! Another vehicle was also recovered under DVLA powers due to being SORN in Newbold Verdon, plus 2 vehicles reported for non conforming plates despite being given a friendly warning previously, one of which also had no MOT and a query over the insurance.

Officers attended a residential property in Twycross recently per the request of the Leicestershire Fire & Rescue Service. Their forensics team could not rule out arson so our Crime Scene Investigators attended. CCTV and house to house enquiries were conducted and an investigation is ongoing. No persons were injured.
