- **Priority 1: Drug activity in the area of Glenhills Boulevard.**

You said: Drug Activity around Glenhills Boulevard

- **Priority 3: Anti-social behaviour in Aylestone Meadows.**

You said: Anti Social Behaviour in and around Aylestone Meadow

We did: We have increased our presence in Aylestone Meadows and dealt with a number of minor incidents of anti-social behaviour, including the use of motorbikes and drug activity. We have seen an increase in graffiti and so will be trying to identify those responsible. If you have information that could help us, you can report it anonymously through the Crimestoppers website.

Positive Results around Aylestone

While on the way back to the station to finish their shift, our PCSOs spotted a vehicle travelling along Aylestone Road at a very low speed and crossing road markings onto the wrong side of the road.

PCSOs followed the vehicle until it came to a stop and approached the driver to speak with them. Upon doing so, they detected the smell of alcohol.

Police officers arrived on scene and the driver was subsequently arrested on suspicion of drink driving.

This is another great example of how PCSOs play a vital role in supporting frontline policing and helping to keep our communities and roads safe.

Car Cruise stopped on Aylestone

on patrol spotted a convoy of vehicles driving in an anti-social manner and displaying poor driving standards along Aylestone Road and Belvoir Drive.

All vehicles parked up and stopped and drivers were spoken to about their manner of driving and the dangers associated with it.

Section 59 warnings were also issued to drivers involved.

This action sends a clear message that anti-social driving will not be tolerated. If this behaviour continues, police have powers to seize vehicles involved.
