- Priority 1: Burglaries
- There has been a number of street consultations over the recent months conducted by local PCSO's and Police volunteers offering crime prevention advice. Alongside the prevention, Police Officers have conducted a number of plain clothes/ uniformed patrols across the beat. Please keep an eye out across our social media platforms, neighbourhood link and engagements for more information and advice.

Priority 2: ASB (In open spaces)

The beat team will continue to monitor the abandoned sites across the beat such as The Cricket Pavilion, Ratcliffe Road, Mary GEE Building and Brookside court, Cademan Close.

The Pavilion has recently been served with a CPN Community Protection Notice. Which means the owners of the site Have several tasks to adhere to so that the site is kept safe.

Priority 3: ASB including drug use, in the area of Church Lane.

We have spoken with several groups of youths that have been hanging around the area and educated them.
