### What matters to you

Priority 1: Burglaries.

You said: That you were concerned that your neighbourhood is prone to Burglaries.

We did: The team have been out and about on the beat posting leaflets about crime prevention, to educate on how to keep your home and valuables safe now darker nights are drawing in. We will continue to conducts high visible patrols and maintain a strong policing presence in the community, we will also be holding beat engagements for crime prevention tips.

Priority 2: ASB in Laureston Drive.

**You said**: That you have experienced anti social behaviour in the area of Laureston Drive.

**We did**: We have been increased patrols of Laureston Drive, we have spoken with a few drivers of vehicles that gathered in the area, and advised them to moved on as this was upsetting the local residents.

Priority 3: Road Safety

**You said**: That road safety was a concern across the beat.

We did: The team have continued to conduct patrols in these areas to deter issues and try and identify suspects, officers spoke with several drivers and educated about speed awareness across Knighton as some of the road speeds have been lowered to 20mph.

#### **Other Local News**

We have been conducting several patrols in the area to educate people on the laws of riding an E-scooter. It is illegal to ride an E-scooter on a public highway, you are only allowed to ride on private land with the land owners permission. We will be conducting a few speed Ops within the next few weeks on several locations across the Knighton ward as you have raised that this was an issue.

Some of our officers conducted a scooter and E-bike Op, which was quite successful they managed to seize 11 E-scooters and 2 E-bikes.
