## What matters to you

We have identified the following priorities which are in place from 1st July 2025:

- **Priority 1: ASB**

**You Said:** You have concerns around the issues we have had in previous years with off road bikes on the recreation ground and other open spaces.

**We Did:** We have been completing high visibility patrols in the hotspot areas - Hillsborough Road, Sturdee Road, Queens Park Way and the Exchange Park - during the summer holidays. We have visited victims and perpetrators of ASB, offering advice and reassurance. We have dealt with offenders appropriately such as with verbal warnings, warning letters or further sanctions. Work continues in this area.

- **Priority 2: Drug Dealing**

**You Said:** We continue to carry this priority forward over the summer months as you have advised us this remains a serious issue. We will continue to tackle those who blight the local area with drugs.

**We Did:** Patrols have continued around identified hotspot areas including; Hillsborough Road, Swinford Avenue and Queens Park Way. We have continued to act upon intelligence received to us - we welcome any reports with information regarding drugs and this will be followed up on by your local beat team. We have also completed a warrant at an address on Grange Drive.

- **Priority 3: Robbery**

**You Said:** There have been several robberies in the area of Swinford Avenue which we are aware have caused some concern in the community.

**We Did:** Plain clothed and uniformed patrols have been taking place across the estate and we are persistently patrolling areas which are linked to incidents of this type.

- The local beat team has secured a closure order against a property on Glenhills Boulevard. This is following a series of proactive enforcement actions targeting drug-related activity in the area. Working in close collaboration with Leicester City Council, officers built a strong intelligence picture around the address, which had become a persistent source of community harm. The closure order marks a significant step in tackling anti-social behaviour and drug misuse on the estate, reflecting the team's ongoing commitment to tackling the issues that matter most to you.
