We have listened to you and the concerns you raised and prioritized the following:

Priority 1: Rural Crime (Including burglary)

You said: Rural Crime is a priority with a high emphasis on burglaries and thefts from vans and cars.

Priority 2: Road Safety

You Said: Road Safety continues to be an issue particularly speeding in the rural areas and through busy villages and obstruction caused by parking.

Priority 3: Antisocial Behavior

You said: Anti-social behavior was a priority.

You Said

Rural crime Including Burglary-

Reports of theft from cars and vans are on the increase, as well as reports of burglaries to residential properties.

Road Safety and parking-

A rise in vehicles driving without Valid MOT or Tax or Insurance has spiked

Anti-social Behaviour-

Now that we are in the summer months, anti-social behavior reports including noise complaints have continued.

We Did

Rural crime Including Burglary-

Officers have conducted late night patrols as well as overnight patrols of residential areas to deter those looking to commit vehicle crime and burglaries as well as lots of stop checks being completed to gain vital intelligence. Road Safety and parking-

Officers have seized multiple cars this month for no MOT and no Tax. It is the responsibility of the owner of the vehicle to make sure that their car has a valid MOT and tax otherwise they are at risk of getting their vehicle seized by police.

Anti-Social Behaviour-

Reports of anti-social behaviors received into the beat team has decreased in recent weeks despite the hot weather and schools closing however officers are still recent reports of the smell of cannabis being used as well as noise complaints. The Beat Team work in partnership with Hinckley and Bosworth Borough Council Anti-Social Behaviour team re these issues.
