What matters to you

We have identified the following priorities which are in place as of 1st July 2026:

- **Priority 1: Anti-Social Behaviour (ASB)**

You Said: ASB is prevalent in the local area and continues to cause concerns, particularly within the estate.

We Did: Officers have continued to carry out high-visibility patrols in identified hotspot locations to deter anti-social behaviour and provide reassurance to the community. We have worked with partner agencies to identify those responsible for repeat incidents, with positive action taken where appropriate. Local officers will continue to engage with young people and residents to address concerns and prevent further issues.

- **Priority 2: Drug Dealing**

You Said: Drug dealing continues to be a key issue around the estate.

We Did: Tackling drug dealing and drug use remains a key priority for police. Officers continue to carry out targeted operations based on local intelligence and are working closely with Leicester City Council to take action against addresses linked to drug-related activity.

- **Priority 3: Off-Road Vehicles**

You Said: In previous years as we head towards the summer, off-road bikes and quad bikes start to become an issue – being ridden illegally and dangerously in open and green spaces.

We Did: As reports of off-road bikes begin to increase during the lighter evenings, we continue to run Op Yatter. Officers have carried out targeted patrols in known hotspot locations. We are gathering intelligence, identifying offenders, and taking enforcement action where offences are detected. Residents are encouraged to continue reporting incidents, including descriptions, locations, times and, where safe to do so, images or video footage, to help us tackle this issue effectively.

Other Local News

- ◆ This week whilst patrolling the Ambleside Spinney officers have come across a burnt out motorbike in the woods. As there were no markings on the bike we were unable to recover it due to its location. As such this was reported to the council via [Love Clean Streets](#) . If you ever come across any eyesores whilst out and about you can report this to the council via the Love Clean Streets app on your phone and they will come and clean the area.
- ◆ The local team continue to work with our partner agencies to tackle the issues that matter to you most. We work with the Leicester City Council community safety team to help deal with perpetrators of antisocial behaviour whilst also dealing with the perpetrators in an appropriate manner. Antisocial behaviour remains one of our beat priorities, especially during the summer months.
- ◆ Op Yatter continues into August. This Op focuses on off road motorbikes being ridden in an antisocial manner. As one of our beat priorities we will continue to combat the issue in a variety of ways and continue to work with other police teams, such as the drone team and road policing unit to help detect, deter and ultimately deal with repeat offenders.
