You said - We did

- Speeding (34 votes on Neighbourhood Link (NHL)) . Between 01/04/2026 and 30/04/2026 the mobile speed camera visited the A47 six times, A6003 once, and B6047 five times. In total thirty one offences were detected.
- Anti social behaviour (21 votes on NHL) - identifying individuals causing the anti social behaviour. Passing their names to the council to start the incremental approach. Targeting areas of known ASB activity.
- Nuisance motorbikes (19 votes on NHL) - We have been conducting uniformed and marked vehicle patrols in the areas you have told us this is a problem. We have directed officers to these areas in any down time they have to deter these offenders from causing problems in these areas.

Throughout the month, officers have been out on patrol across the area. They started off with patrols on Harvest Way estate. This was in response to reports of anti social behaviour in the area.

The team then continued the day by seizing an electric bike after the rider rode down the A6 towards Kibworth. It was an illegal e- bike which was seized and recovered. This is also a reminder that riding an illegally modified e- bike means it can be seized without warning. We act on the concerns raised by the community and patrol in areas where issues have been raised. This can be done via 101 for non emergency or on the Leicestershire Police Website. 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This month, officers have been patrolling Saddington Car Boot Sale. We'll be carrying out patrols to help identify suspected stolen property, engage with sellers and buyers, and discourage the purchase and sale of items that may be stolen. We'll also be keeping an eye out for trailers and carrying out checks where appropriate. Trailers remain a popular target for thieves, and we don't want anyone to unknowingly buy one that's been stolen and end up losing both the trailer and their cash. Most sellers and shoppers are honest people looking for a good day out and a bargain, and our aim is to keep it that way.
