Your Dedicated Neighbourhood Team (DNT) is a group of local Officers dedicated to serving your community. The team is made up of Officers based in your area and supported by the wider Policing family.

Your priorities are chosen quarterly and are based upon information gathered through NHL (Neighbourhood Link), social media, local engagement, and emerging crime trends. You have stated that the following key themes are important to you. #YouSaidWeDid

You Said	We did
General anti-social behaviour has been raised as a priority by local residents; this includes nuisance by youths at the Meridian Leisure Park	We have received a new report of motorbikes on a Thorpe Astley green area, near the community centre. Officers attended however bikers had left the area. Further work is being completed to identify the perpetrators.
Persons involved in Growing, making, distributing, and taking illegal substances	Two males were stopped on Watergate Lane, Braunstone Town. One found with Cannabis. A Community Resolution was issued by PC 4258 Gilbody.
Road safety in general has been raised as a priority. This includes safety around school pick-up and drop off. Unsafe and uninsured vehicles. It also includes speeding enforcement where it is identified as a problem.	The beat team are not aware of any issues in relation to road safety. The beat team continue to monitor and when available will conduct a speeding operation in the near future.

News

During patrols in a priority area, officers stopped two males and recovered a quantity of drugs. They were dealt with in line with the offences identified. This follows a similar incident in the same location several weeks ago, where other males were also stopped and found in possession of drugs. We will continue targeted patrols to address drug related activity.

We've recently received an increase in reports about motorbikes being ridden in an anti-social or dangerous manner around the Thorpe Astley area. This behaviour puts residents, road users, and the riders themselves at risk. Your local officers are carrying out regular patrols and working to identify those involved. If individuals are identified, appropriate action will be taken — this can include warnings, vehicle seizures, and in some cases prosecution. If you see motorbikes being used anti-socially, please report it. Your information helps us build a clearer picture and take effective action.

PCSO Ryan has created an ECINS report, which is our anti-social behaviour monitoring system, following reports of youths entering a former care home on Camden Road, Braunstone Town and setting off fire extinguishers. If you are aware of these youths or have any CCTV/Ring footage from the 15th February at approximately 1510 hours, please get in touch quoting ref LEP-150226-0399.

Officers attended a burglary on Kingsway North recently where persons had entered the property whilst the family were away. Forensic officers attended the location, and house to house and CCTV enquiries were conducted. This is currently being progressed by CID.
