What matters to you

We have identified the following priorities which are in place from 1st October 2025:

Priority 1: ASB

You Said: We are aware of issues with youths causing anti-social behaviour in the area if Hillsborough Road and Thurcroft Close. We will be working to tackle this issue moving forward.

We Did: We have been completing high visibility patrols in hotspot areas and we will deal with offenders appropriately. Work continues in this area.

Priority 2: Drug Dealing

You Said: We continue to carry this priority forward into October as you have advised us this remains a serious issue. We will continue to tackle those who blight the local area with drugs.

We Did: We continue to act upon intelligence received to us and we welcome any reports with information regarding drugs. This will be followed up on by your local beat team. We are always looking at further warrant applications for problem addresses identified.

• Priority 3: Shoplifting

You Said: There has been an increase in retail theft over the summer months at local stores.

We Did: We are aware of a number of individuals who are regular offenders of shoplifting. We continue our proactive attempts to deal with these people. One individual is now subject to a CBO (Criminal Behaviour Order), which is a court order for persistent offenders to aid in preventing them continuing these actions.

- StreetSafe is a service that allows you to report safety concerns in public places without giving us your name (anonymously). This includes issues like poorly lit streets, abandoned buildings, or vandalism, as well as instances where you feel unsafe due to someone following or verbally abusing you.
