EVINGTON & NORTH EVINGTON BEAT PRIORITIES

(ISSUED 1ST AUGUST 2026)

- Retail premises across the beat area have reported incidents of theft from stores, causing financial loss to businesses and increasing concerns among retailers, staff and customers. Repeat offending and organised shoplifting negatively impact the local economy and community confidence. .
- Reports of anti-social behaviour (ASB) increase during the summer holiday period within parks, open spaces and recreational areas. Issues include nuisance behaviour, alcohol-related disorder, littering, damage to property and activities that negatively affect residents and visitors. .
- Concerns have been raised regarding crime and anti-social behavior at Leicester General Hospital, including theft, disorder, vehicle crime and incidents impacting patients, staff and visitors. Such behaviour affects public safety and the hospital environment. behaviour.

We were pleased to see a strong turnout and value the opportunity to strengthen relationships within the community.

Fortunately, no serious injuries were reported, although the vehicle involved required recovery. During the same shift, the officers carried out enquiries to locate a reported missing person. These incidents demonstrate the professionalism, commitment and teamwork shown by officers in keeping our communities safe and supporting vulnerable individuals.



PCSO Meerun and PCSO 6153 Arichandra carried out high-visibility foot patrols in and around Evington Park, engaging with local residents and providing reassurance to those using the area. These patrols formed part of our ongoing efforts to maintain a visible presence, address community concerns, and help deter anti-social behaviour. Regular engagement with residents enables us to build positive relationships and support a safe and welcoming environment for all.

Planning an event or procession?

Please tell us before it happens

If you are planning a public event (such as a festival, large gathering and sports event), march, procession or protest, please tell us before it happens, by scanning the QR code below.

Sharing information early helps us keep people safe, prevent crime or disorder, and reduce disruption to local communities.

The Council and Police may work with organisers before and during events to support safe and peaceful activity.



What should you tell us about?

Please tell us if you are planning:

- a public event (such as a festival, large gathering and sports event).
- a march or procession.
- a protest or demonstration.



Some processions must be reported by law, at least six days before they take place.

If you do not tell us:

- Some processions may break the law.
- Organisers could be fined.

How to tell us:
