## Team Update

Op Syphon is an East Leicester initiative aimed at addressing road safety concerns, including speeding, dangerous parking, seatbelt usage, and more.

The operation will be progressed in two phases:

### Phase 1: Education

We will focus on educating the public. We will primarily use social media to disseminate educational materials, outlining our expectations for road safety compliance. We will also engage with local schools and in our community meetings to further spread the message.

### Phase 2: Enforcement

We will address road safety concerns through active enforcement. All enforcement activities will be shared via social media and newsletters to keep the public informed.
